5. Buildings – Work Pack for Pupils

We are still unsure about how some of the WW1 buildings were used. This is your chance to think about how the site might have been organised

1. If a building on the plan is still standing you should shade the area that represents it on the plan.
2. Make a list of the sort of things people living and working on the hills would need.
3. Label, with their use in WW1, any buildings you are sure of on the plan.
4. Label the buildings on the plan with your best guess of what they might have been used for. Note down the reasons for your choice!
5. Do you think there are enough buildings to provide all the facilities for the people living and working on the site? What else might have been used to provide facilities? Draw and label your ideas on the plan.
6. How do you think the soldiers stopped unauthorised civilians from getting too near the gun testing.
7. Why do you think some of the buildings were demolished?
8. Why have some buildings survived?
